



Privacy Policy for Personal Data Processing

1. Data Controller

The controller of your personal data is **Match-Trade Technologies LLC**, registered at 16192 Coastal Highway, Lewes, DE 19958, County of Sussex, United States, operating under the laws of the State of Delaware ("Data Controller").

The Data Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer - Mr. Krzysztof Teofilski, e-mail: legal@match-trade.com.

2. Purpose and Legal Basis of Processing

Personal data is processed in connection with the organization of the event "**Perfect Match**", which will take place in Dubai, UAE on February 12, 2026, and related activities, including competitions held during the event and awarding of prizes.

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- Compliance with legal obligations imposed on the Data Controller.
- Legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller, including:
 - Contact related to event organization, participation, and awarding of prizes,
 - Ensuring safety during the event,
 - Marketing communication after the event.

3. Scope of Data Processing

The following categories of personal data will be processed: full name, e-mail address, company name, telephone number, job title.

Data is collected directly from individuals via the online registration form. Providing personal data is mandatory in order to participate in the event.

During the event, photos and video recordings will be taken. As a result, the image of participants may be captured in group photos or recordings. Selected photos may be published on the Data Controller's website and social media profiles.



Participants who object to this should notify the Data Controller before the event starts.

4. Compliance with Applicable Law

The Data Controller processes personal data in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to: (i) the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the laws of the State of Delaware and UAE law.

5. Data Recipients and Transfers

Personal data may be transferred to entities affiliated with the Data Controller and subcontractors involved in the organization of the event.

The Data Controller may transfer personal data between the USA and the EEA only when necessary and with an adequate level of protection, primarily through the use of Standard Contractual Clauses issued by the European Commission.

6. Automated Decision-Making

Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling, that produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you.

7. Data Retention Period

The retention period depends on the purpose of processing:

- (i) data processed on the basis of legal obligations – retained for the period required by law;
- (ii) data processed on the basis of legitimate interest – retained until the interest is fulfilled or an effective objection is raised;
- (iii) data may be retained longer if necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims.

After the retention period, data will be irreversibly deleted or anonymized.

8. Your Rights

In connection with the processing of personal data, you have the following rights: (i) Right to information – to obtain details about the purposes, legal grounds, scope, recipients, and planned retention period of data; (ii) Right to obtain a copy of your data; (iii) Right to rectification – to correct inaccurate or incomplete personal data; (iv) Right to erasure (“right



to be forgotten") – to request deletion of data no longer necessary for the purposes collected; (v) Right to restriction of processing – to temporarily stop data operations in certain cases; (vi) Right to data portability – to receive your data in a structured, commonly used format or request its transfer to another entity; (vii) Right to object to processing for marketing purposes; (ix) Right to object to processing for other legitimate interests – based on your particular situation; (x) Right to lodge a complaint – with a supervisory authority in your country of habitual residence, workplace, or place of the alleged violation.
